

Ohio Doctor of Medicine (MD) and Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine (DO) License Application

Ohio's MD and DO license application process is now completely electronic. The State Medical Board of Ohio no longer accepts paper applications or payments via check. All applications for licensure must be submitted via the State of Ohio's eLicense portal located at eLicense.ohio.gov.

Federation Credentials Verification Service (FCVS)

During the Ohio eLicense application process, you will be asked for your Federation Credentials Verification Service (FCVS) ID. This ID is required to verify your profile is complete, and you have requested your profile to be sent to the State Medical Board of Ohio. Please note, you will not be able to submit and pay for the Ohio MD or DO license application unless your FCVS is complete and you have requested it to be sent to the State Medical Board of Ohio.

Uniform Application (UA)

The State Medical Board of Ohio <u>does not require</u> the Uniform Application (UA). However, if you have completed a UA you may use it to populate some data into the Ohio license application. Please note, there are still supplemental questions to be answered to complete your Ohio MD or DO license application.

After entering your FCVS ID, you will be prompted to enter your UA ID. If you have not completed a UA you may simply continue with the Ohio MD or DO license application by leaving the field blank and clicking CONTINUE.
